At the outset of the meeting the Chairman welcomed all the participants and asked the Director General Family Welfare, J&K to brief the Committee. Director General Family Welfare J&K made a presentation and gave a detailed analysis of all the Failure, Complication and Death Cases. The Chairman enquired about the possible reasons for the Death cases. The Assistant Director Family Welfare Jammu Dr. Suman Gupta explained that both the deaths occurred due to Cardiac Pulmonary Arrest. The Chairman also sought the reasons for most of the failure cases being from Udhampur district and

for this he suggested that a study needs to be initiated and asked for mapping of geographical locations, possible impacts on the sterilization campaign and surgical implications.

The meeting concluded with the approval of all the failure, complication and death cases for the period 2019-20, 2020-21 and 2021-22 (ending December 2021) for the disbursement of compensation claims to the claimants.
