**Sub: Request for supply of COVISHIELD vaccine.**

Sir,


In pursuance to the D.O. letter vide No. 1920764/2020-Imm. dated: 23-04-2021 issued by the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, GoI, regarding the phase 3 strategy of the National Covid-19 vaccination programme from 1<sup>st</sup> May 2021. The UT Government of J&K has decided to introduce the new initiative w.e.f. 5<sup>th</sup> May 2021 where all eligible population between 18-45 years shall be vaccinated.

Subsequent to the above mentioned vaccination strategy and guidelines, the Directorate of Family Welfare, MCH & Immunization, J&K proposes to procure a total of **1,24,00,00 (one Crore Twenty Four Lakh) Doses (64 lakh for Kashmir Division and 60 lakh for Jammu Division)** in a phased manner with a period of 3-4 months. It is further to intimate that Dr. Shahid Hussain; State Immunization Officer is the Nodal Person for this distribution of Vaccine in the UT of J&K.

Therefore, in the first instance, I am directed to request to may kindly make it convenient to place an order for procurement out of the above said total requirement as per the below given schedule:

1. 5<sup>th</sup> May 2021 = 40 lakh Doses
2. 5<sup>th</sup> June 2021 = 42 lakh Doses
3. 5<sup>th</sup> July 2021 = 42 lakh Doses
